

Forensic Accounting, Certificate

Any student seeking a business degree is eligible for an undergraduate Certificate in Forensic Accounting. This represents a multidisciplinary approach to demonstrate their focused study in this specific area of expertise and to increase employment opportunities. Completion of the required coursework will further prepare undergraduate business students for additional professional examinations, including those for Certified Fraud Examiners (CFE) and Certified Public Accountant (CPA).
